Free Flute! is an exploration in extended flute techniques. The piece focuses on the idea of metamorphosis. After a brief introduction, the first iteration of our three note motif is introduced to begin the first melodic phrase. This three note gesture is what drives the piece forward and, throughout its changes, explores all the possible registers, modes, and techniques used in this piece. Listen, as this simple, three-note gesture takes on unique voices and characters of its own as the piece unfolds.
